TNEBEA extends its wishes to the Chairman cum Managing Director/ TANGEDCO.

The Additional Charge Arrangements for the post of Assistant Executive Engineers and Assistant Engineers in thermal stations are not sanctioned for long period and recoveries were made for engineers who had extended their service on addition to their section works, sub division works based on the clarification (Ref 1) issued by Secretary/ TANGEDCO.

The Secretary/ TANGEDCO had issued a clarification vide reference (1) above, regarding making Additional Charge arrangement for the posts below the rank of Executive Engineers in Thermal Power Stations. In that clarification, it is stated as follows,

*"It is iterated that there is only two types of posts in Thermal Stations wise 1) Office Post 2) Plant Post. The concept of field post does not exist in Thermal Stations as all the Officials work in the same jurisdictional areas".*

In this juncture, TNEBEA like to intervene the wrong misinterpretation of terming the posts available in the thermal plants as a new coined word of "Plant post" which was not stipulated in our board regulations and all the posts are considered and categorised as Office posts and Field posts only.

In this regard a letter vide Ref (2) clearly justifying the Role of Assistant Engineers and Assistant Executive Engineers as Field Engineers in thermal power stations was addressed to the secretary / TANGEDCO and clarification was requested.
