bub: Possibility of huge loss to TANGEDCO in view of the tariff hike suggested at rate of 2.18% instead of 4.7% as indicated in the Press Release dated 06.06.2023 Need for for reimbursing addressing the GOTN suitable subsidy to TANGEDCO working out based on tariff hike at the rate of 4.7% -Remedial action requested - Reg.

This Association is duty bound to bring the following facts to the kind notice of respected CMD for scope of loss to TANGEDCO, if the tariff hike at the rate of 2.18% instead of 4.7% as announced in the Press Release dated 06.06.2023 is left unaltered/ unamended. It is stated therein that the brices of the consumer tariff will be hiked by considering difference the 2.18%, Consumer Price Index (CPI) as on August 2022 and on April, 2023. It is further clarified that the GOTN will bear this tariff hike to the tune of 2.18% n respect of domestic category and it will be reimbursed by way of subsidy to the TANGEDCO.

- In this connection, this Association desires to bring the following pertinent points for kind perusal of the respected CMD/TANGEDCO:
- (a) The Hon'ble TNERC, in its tariff order dated 09-09-2022, has adopted the annual escalation method of retail tariff for the purpose of meeting out the annual increase in average cost of supply. The relevant portion of the provisions in the tariff order is extracted as below:

"6.1.1.13 The applicable tariff for ensuing years of control period may be as per prevailing tariff x {(1+(CPI of April of respective financial year – CPI of April of previous financial year)/ CPI of April of previous financial year)} or 6% whichever is lower with effect from 1st July of respective financial year."

(b) The CPI as on April, 2023 and as on April, 2022 are 178.1 and 170.1. respectively. The escalation of tariff,in accordance with the rate of escalation prescribed under the tariff order dated 09.09.2022 of the Hon'ble TNERC, works out to 4.7%, as below:

Escalation (April 2022 as base) =
$$(178.1-170.1)$$
x100 = 170.1 = 4.7%

(c) Instead of considering April 2022 as base date, the escalation is worked out considering the CPI as on August, 2022 as base date, which is worked out as below:

Escalation (August 2022 as base) =
$$\frac{178.1 - 174.3}{174.3} \times 100$$

= 2.18%

- (d) The above is a clear case of incorrect decision, since it contravenes the provisions of the Tariff Order dated 09.09.2022.
- (e) Tariff escalation at the rate 2.18% instead of 4.7% as guaranteed under the tariff order dated 09.09.2022 of Hon'ble TNERCleads to heavy financial loss to TANGEDCO.
- (f) It is imperative that the Government of Tamil Nadu must be addressed for reimbursing enhanced subsidy at the rate 4.7% hike as per TNERC norms instead of 2.18% as notified in the Press Release.
- 3. TANGEDCO has passed orders to the effect that DA and other benefits announced for the State Government employees should not be extended to the employees of TANGEDCO, christening it as a loss-making State-owned PSU without prior approval of the Finance Department, vide (Per) FB TANGEDCO Proceedings No. 2 dated 12.04.2022.
- 4. This Association is constrained to emphasize that engineers and employees of TANGEDCO are not responsible for the loss in any manner. It is certainly due to the policy decisions of Government of Tamil Nadu and TANGEDCO. This Association respectfully admits that the Government of Tamil Nadu is fully empowered to consider any policy decision in the interest of public welfare especially the downtrodden. TANGEDCO is also one of the Government Departments like Health, Education, PWD, Highways etc. implementing the social welfare measures announced by the GOTN. While profit / loss factor is not considered for the Government department, it is disheartening to label TANGEDCO, yet another government body caring for the public welfare, as a loss-making undertaking and treats its engineers and employees at a different and discriminating footing.
- 5. This Association solemnly affirms our firm commitment and unstinted cooperation for implementing all welfare measures announced by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Our plight is just
